Major measure implemented in 2024

- Draftstrips have been renewed on the top floor (office) of Scheepmakersweg
- Paper cups have been replaced with Clarksons mugs.
- Remarkable tablets have been purchased for Management.
- Lighting in the toilets has been replaced by LED with motion sensors.

Other measures in 2024:

- Better insight into our consumption by contracting a consultancy firm
- Installing charging stations for electric vehicles Westlob 9 Eemshaven.
- Application for a subsidy for solar panels and charging stations Westlob 9 Eemshaven.

Measures:

To continue reducing CO2, Clarksons is taking the following measures this year:

- We want to save even more paper by installing hand dryers in the toilets. We will find out in 2025 what the savings may be.
- We want to see if it is possible to make the balustrade on the 1st floor draught-proof, so that less heating is required in the office. A quote for this will be requested in 2025.
- In 2025, we will ask P&D for advice on how we can best consume or store the electricity we generate. This has already been initiated.
